

# Jean-Yves Scoazec

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## Brief Bio

Jean-Yves Scoazec obtained his MD degree in 1983 and his PhD degree in 1992. He was Associate Professor of Cell Biology at Faculté Bichat, Université Paris 7, until 1997. He was then appointed Professor of Pathology in Université Lyon 1 from 1997 to 2014. From 2007 to 2011, he was director of the INSERM research unit “Digestive endocrine tumors: mechanisms of tumorigenesis and tumor progression” (INSERM UMR 865) and from 2012 to 2014, he was director of the team “Endocrine differentiation: interactions with tumorigenesis and tumor progression”, member of the Lyon Cancer Research Center, of which Jean-Yves Scoazec was also deputy director. He is director of ANIPATH, a facility of Université Lyon 1 dedicated to the histopathology of small laboratory animals.

From 2014, Jean-Yves Scoazec has been appointed Professor of Pathology at Université Paris XI, head of surgical pathology and molecular pathology in the department of Biopathology, Gustave Roussy Cancer Center, Villejuif and director of MAMICA (Molecular Analysis, Modelling and Imaging of Cancer), INSERM US23/CNRS UMS3655, Villejuif.

The diagnostic activities of Jean-Yves Scoazec are focused on gastro-intestinal and liver diseases. In last years, his personal research interests have been mainly centered on digestive neuroendocrine tumors and on mechanisms of epithelial carcinogenesis in the gastro-intestinal tract and the liver.

Jean-Yves Scoazec has published more than 400 papers in international journals. He was a member of the board of the Groupe Français des Tumeurs endocrines (GTE) and of the Advisory Board of ENETS. He is the coordinator of the French national expert network for the pathological diagnosis of neuroendocrine tumors of the adult, supported by Institut National du Cancer (INCa).
